



## **SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2010**

### **OBJECTIVE**

To give credit union employees and or volunteers the opportunity to improve their skills, enhance their career and assist to expand their knowledge of the credit union movement.

### **SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY**

- Must have at least six months full-time service with a credit union.
- Must be an employee or volunteer of a credit union that is a member of the NNMCCU at the time of application and on the date scholarship will be received.
- Must have a letter from President/CEO recommending you to attend class desired.

### **APPLICATIONS**

Scholarship applicants must submit a letter explaining why they want to take the class (es) and describe the benefits they expect to gain from this class (es). They should also include a description of the class or school program (preferably a printed brochure) and verification of related costs to attend.

A written request and supporting documents must be received by the Northern New Mexico Chapter Scholarship Committee at the address provided no later than March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2010.

### **ELIGIBLE CLASSES/ SCHOOLS**

Classes must be “position related” to the extent that such classes would improve the skills and/or knowledge used within a credit union on a day-to-day basis for the applicant’s current job or board position or a position he or she may aspire to hold in the future. Determination of the position relatedness will be up to the – Northern New Mexico Chapter Scholarship Committee.
